Stirling, NJ – On December 10th, at 2:00 p.m., the First Presbyterian Church of Stirling will present classical pianist Nicholas Hrynyk. Mr. Hrynyk is the 2016 winner of the New York State MTNA-Steinway Young Artist Piano Competition. He has performed at Carnegie Hall, Lincoln Center's School of American Ballet, National Opera Center, New York Fashion Week, Chautauqua Music Festival, Skaneateles Music Festival, and the Moulin d'Ande Cultural Center in France. He has appeared with the Auburn Chamber Orchestra playing piano concerti of Grieg and Schumann.

A passionate educator, Nicholas teaches privately in New York City and he is also on the faculty at Riverside Music Studios and the Kaufman Music Center's Lucy Moses School. He previously taught at New York University as an Adjunct Instructor and Indiana University as an Associate Instructor. Nicholas holds Bachelor's and Master's degrees in Piano Performance from the Eastman School of Music and Indiana University, as well as an Advanced Certificate in Music Education from New York University Steinhardt. His mentors include Deirdre O'Donohue, Arnaldo Cohen, and Natalya Antonova.

Recent highlights include the release of "Love Unspoken", a studio album of duos for violin and piano, and an appointment at New York University as staff pianist for the spring of 2018.
