Russian-born and New York-based pianist Anna Keiserman is known for her creative programming, expressive freedom and singular vision. As a soloist Anna has performed concerti by Rachmaninoff, Haydn, Beethoven and Arensky with the Volgograd Symphony Orchestra, and also toured through Italy and Russia. Among Dr. Keiserman's awards are top prizes in two international piano competitions in Russia: one based in Volgograd, the other in Saratov. Recently Anna was awarded 3rd place in the "American Prize in Piano Performance" competition.

Ms. Keiserman's program will include Rachmaninoff's "Etudes-Tableaux op.33 », Alexander Krein's "Two Poems op. 11", Marc Migó's "Four Preludes", and 4 selections from Rodion Shchedrin: "A la Albeniz, Troika, Two-part Invention, and Basso Ostinato.

This will be the third concert in the Church's concert series for the 2019 – 2020 season. Admission, as always, is free. A short reception will follow the concert at which attendees may meet the performer. Refreshments will be served.
